CLASSROOM

OFFICE

The main office is where everyone goes to receive important information.

MAIL ROOM

The mail room is where mail gets sorted and packaged before going out to teachers.

CAFETERIA

The cafeteria is where everyone gets fed to get the energy they need for the day.

SUPPORT STRUCTURE

The school is supported by steel beams and concrete walls for stability and shape.

TEACHER

The teacher gets information from the main office and shares with students.

FRONT DOOR

The front door can be locked or unlocked to allow people to enter and leave the school when its time.
